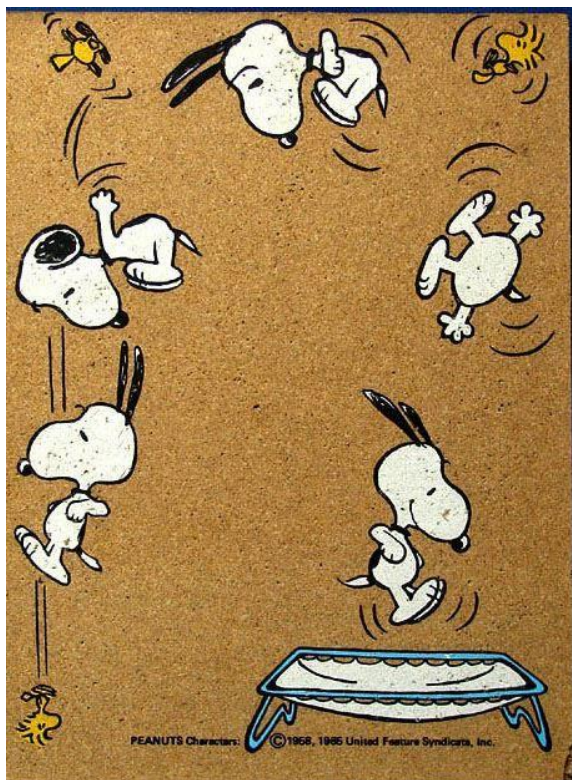

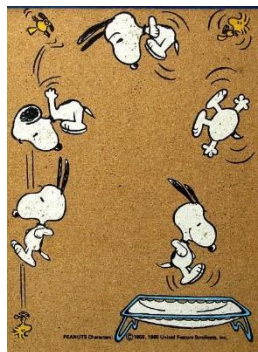

MSCA – Individual Fellowships - IF

- wszystkie dyscypliny naukowe, wszystkie typy badań i innowacji
- doświadczony naukowiec – dr albo 4 lata doświadczenia naukowego licząc od mgr
- European Fellowship: 12 lub 24 m-ce w kraju UE lub stowarzyszonym z H2020
- Global Fellowship: 12 lub 24 m-ce poza UE, ale obowiązkowa faza powrotna do UE na 12 m-cy
- Zatrudnienie!
- badania naukowe + szkolenie się





MSCA – Individual Fellowships - IF

- **European Fellowship:**
 - Standard EF – naukowiec dowolnej narodowości, 8 paneli tematycznych
 - Career Restart panel – naukowiec dowolnej narodowości, warunek: nie pracował badawczo przynajmniej 12 miesięcy liczone ciągiem bezpośrednio przed terminem zakończenia naboru wniosków;
 - Reintegration panel – naukowiec z krajów UE lub stowarzyszonych z H2020 lub długoterminowy rezydent, przebywający przez dłuższy czas w kraju trzecim, który chce powrócić do pracy w Europie
 - Society and Enterprise panel – gdy jako instytucję goszczącą wybiera się organizacje z sektora poza-akademickiego (ale nadal ma to być praca badawcza!)

- for the return phase: the coefficient of the country where the researcher returns to (i.e. the country of the beneficiary).

🌐 KARIERA I MOBILNOŚĆ – rozwój kadry i kariery naukowej

Jedną z kluczowych polityk realizacji Europejskiej Przestrzeni Badawczej i Strategii EUROPA 2020 jest **rozwój naukowego potencjału intelektualnego Europejczyków** poprzez finansowanie różnego rodzaju grantów i projektów, o które ubiegają się instytucje (bądź konsorcja instytucji) oraz indywidualni naukowcy we współpracy w instytucjach ich przyjmujących. Podstawowym źródłem finansowania projektów są wspólnotowe programy ramowe oraz fundusze poszczególnych krajów. Realizacja polityk europejskich jest wspierana przez różne **inicjatywy** mające na celu likwidowanie barier dotyczących rozwoju kariery naukowej oraz mobilności międzynarodowej i międzysektorowej.

EURAXESS: kariera naukowa, mobilność międzynarodowa

EURAXESS to europejska inicjatywa koordynowana przez Komisję Europejską, działająca od 2004 r. w 40 krajach europejskich, która wspiera naukowców i ich pracodawców poprzez:

- 📄 **Europejski portal EURAXESS** zawierający **największą w Europie bazę ofert pracy, grantów naukowych i ofert goszczących** z instytucji, gdzie naukowcy mogą zamieszczać swoje CV, a pracodawcy oferty. Naukowcy znajdują tam również informacje o europejskich politykach dot. kariery naukowej. Część PARTNERING służy do poszukiwania partnerów do współpracy badawczej, zarówno indywidualnych naukowców, jak i instytucji badawczych. Wszystkie te opcje są **bezpłatne** i dostępne po założeniu i zalogowaniu się do własnego profilu. **Polskie uczelnie, instytuty Polskiej Akademii Nauk oraz instytuty badawcze mają obowiązek** (zgodnie z odpowiednimi ustawami) zamieszczać oferty pracy naukowej, w tym finansowane z projektów Horyzontu 2020, w bazie EURAXESS Komisji Europejskiej.
- 📄 **480 Centrow EURAXESS**, zlokalizowanych w 40 krajach w Europie, udzielających informacji naukowcom i pracodawcom o **procedurach zatrudnienia i warunkach życia** w danym kraju, wspierającym w załatwianiu formalności ([INFORMATION & ASSISTANCE](#));
- 📄 **40 krajowych portali EURAXESS** z informacjami o krajowych funduszach, przepisach prawno-administracyjnych związanych z **wyjazdem, przyjazdem i pracą w danym kraju**.

Polska strona EURAXESS (www.euraxess.pl) – to jedyna strona z informacjami o przepisach związanych z przyjazdem i zatrudnieniem w Polsce naukowca z zagranicy, wyjazdem za granicę oraz z aktualnymi ofertami krajowych i zagranicznych grantów i stypendiów. W zakładce PRACODAWCY znajdują Państwo również informacje o [Europejskiej Karcie Naukowca](#) i [Kodeksie Postępowania przy rekrutacji pracowników naukowych](#) oraz [logo HR Excellence in Research](#).

HORYZONT 2020: finansowanie grantów badawczych i szkoleniowych

Horyzont 2020 (2014-2020) jest największym w historii Unii Europejskiej programem finansowania badań naukowych i innowacji z budżetem **77 028,3 mln euro**. Niezwykle różnorodna oferta programu obejmuje wiele typów projektów badawczych i szkoleniowych służących rozwojowi kapitału intelektualnego, z których korzystać mogą zarówno instytucje (nie tylko naukowe; również m.in. przedsiębiorstwa), jak i indywidualni naukowcy.
