


#### Call ID

- COS-SEM-2020-4-01 call for proposals
- Budget: EUR 1 900 000
  - 19 projects
  - maximum grant per project EUR 100 000
- Project duration: up to 12 months
- Electronic submission: Funding and tenders portal
- Deadline for submission of proposals: 9 June 2020

## **Background and policy context**

- Need to provide a targeted tool for boosting interregional collaboration in the field of social economy;
- Outcome of various discussions, workshops and stakeholder conferences (ESER, GSEF, GECES etc.);
- Inter-regional collaboration in social economy based on sharing of good practices and mutual learning





## Objectives of the call



- Enhancing interaction and improving collaboration between existing social economy networks and stakeholders at regional and local level in the field of priorities of "Social economy missions";
- Boosting inter-regional learning between social economy stakeholders (public and private sector) in the field of priorities of "Social economy missions";
- Contributing to a gradual building of a Social Economy community.



## Topics of "Social Economy Missions" &



- Building resilient regional and/or local ecosystems;
- 2. Socially responsible public procurement;
- 3. Building Clusters of Social and Ecological Innovation or participation in traditional clusters;
- 4. Support to social economy business development;
- 5. Support to local and regional initiatives in the area of green and digital transition;
- 6. Local or regional measures tackling unemployment;
- 7. Sustainable agriculture and rural development;
- 8. Education and training to develop the social economy ecosystem;
- 9. The development of horizontal policies to support social economy at local or regional level;
- 10. Social economy initiatives to integrate migrants;
- 11. Other (identified by the applicants).



#### **Activities**



- Kick-off meeting
- EC guidance on participatory methods for planning and organising workshops
- Three compulsory workshops
  - methodology, duration and location
  - delegations consisting of social economy stakeholders active in a given territory
  - collecting and publishing good practices
- Additional learning activities (optional)



#### **Deliverables**



- Three workshops
- Three workshop reports with good practices published at the <u>Social Economy Community collaborative website</u> in requested templates
- Final report (see section 12 of call for proposals).



## **Admissibility requirements**

- Electronic submission: Funding and tenders portal
- Before the deadline: 9 June 2020, 17.00 Brussels time
- Applications must be complete
- Submitted in one of the official EU languages

## Criteria (eligibility)



- Legal entities forming a consortium established in EU member states or <u>COSME</u> countries
- Coordinator > must be regional or local public administration
- **Partners** > must be regional or local public administration
  - > can be network or umbrella organisations in the field of social economy or social entrepreneurship or related issues at inter-regional, national, EU or COSME countries' level
- Min 3 regional or local public administration from 3 different countries (does not apply to EU's outermost regions or OCTs)
- Regional or local public administration cannot participate in more than 1 proposal (*Annex 3 of DoA*). Network or umbrella organisations and members of the territorial delegations can participate in more than one proposal.

#### **Criteria**



- Exclusion criteria > Declaration on honour
- Selection criteria
  - a) Financial capacity > EU Validation Services before grant signature
  - b) Operational capacity > Declaration on honour, Team responsible for the project, References (*Annex 2 of DoA*)
- Award criteria > Relevance, Quality, Impact, Cost effectiveness



## **Electronic submission**



#### ... via Funding and tenders portal

- Part A
  - (1) General information including a short abstract of the proposal and declarations on behalf of the consortium partners
  - (2) Administrative data of participating organisations
  - (3) Budget for the proposal (per partner: total estimated eligible costs and requested grant in €).
- Part B
  - Description of the Action (Technical Annex 1) template
  - Budget template (Technical Annex 2) template



## Don't forget!



- At least 3 regional or local public administration from 3 EU/COSME countries (except for EU outermost and OCT regions and territories)
- At least 3 workshops to be organised
- Implementation up to 12 months
- Coordinator and partners must lead territorial delegations
- Network or umbrella organisations in the field of social economy or social entrepreneurship or related issues at inter-regional, national, EU or COSME countries' level can participate as partners



## Tips



Read carefully the call text. Check the <u>Guide for applicants</u>, the templates and annexes.



Regularly check the Q&A on **EASME** website.



Check the completeness of your proposal before submission.



Do not submit your proposal at the last moment!
