We would like to kindly inform you that the National Centre for Research and Development (NCBiR) has announced a call for applications for project funding under the **LIDER XII programme**, the purpose of which is to support the development of young scientists (Article 360 (2) of the Law on Higher Education and Science) through activities aimed at increasing competences in the field of independent planning, management and leadership of a research team during the implementation of research projects, the results of which may be applied in practice and have implementation potential.

Applications to NCBiR may be submitted **from 18 January to 18 March 2021** (until 4.15 pm).

Call rules:

- The applicant may be an individual who conducts research or development work and meets the basic criterion - he is a young scientist, i.e. he is a doctoral student or academic teacher - and does not have a doctoral degree or has a doctoral degree, which has not been obtained for 7 years and is employed under an employment contract in the unit.
- R&D personnel forming the research team are persons who are under 35 years of age and will be employed in the unit for the period of work on the project implementation.
- The project implementation period cannot be shorter than 12 months and longer than 36 months.
- The maximum level of co-financing for a project is 100%, and the maximum value of co-financing is PLN 1.5 million.
- Co-financing covers the costs of the research project implementation in accordance with the catalogue of eligible costs (Annex 2 to the Regulations), including the remuneration of the project manager and members of the research team. The forms and rates of remuneration must comply with the Remuneration Regulations for employees of the Jagiellonian University.
- Indirect costs are settled on a flat-rate basis at the level of 25% of eligible costs, excluding category E (subcontracting costs).
- The cost of purchase or production of scientific equipment / devices for research purposes will be an eligible cost of the project, if this cost relates to the equipment necessary for the proper implementation of the project and is directly used for its implementation, and the following conditions are jointly met:
 - the value of equipment, IT infrastructure or other device (hardware) does not exceed PLN 500,000,
 - the entity has no equipment / fixed asset that could be used interchangeably.
- An applicant may submit only 1 application in the call, while an entity may appear in more than one application.

Form of submitting applications:

The application should be prepared and then submitted only in the electronic version in the LSI system. The application should be accompanied by attachments in the form of a scan of a hand-signed document or a document bearing a qualified electronic signature. Detailed rules for completing and submitting the application are specified in the *Application Submission Instructions and the LSI System Application Submission Instructions*.

• **by 11 March 2021:** the final version of the application i.e. the full version of the application (electronic version sent as a PDF file with a qualified signature or acceptance by e-mail or in the form of a scan with signatures - signatures required Principal Investigator and the Dean of the Faculty, or as appropriate to the specifics of the unit).

An electronic application may be sent in the LSI system only after approval by the JU authorities. The application signed by the JU authorities will be sent to the e-mail addresses provided by you by the competition supervisor at CAWP.

The application must be sent in the LSI system no later than March 18, 2021, by 4.15 pm.
