on: application of scientists of the Jagiellonian University to perform the role of supervisor in Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral Fellowships (Horizon Europe) projects

I would like to kindly inform you that a call for proposals for Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral Fellowships projects under the new Horizon Europe program will be opened soon.

The call for proposals is planned from **18 May 2021 to 15 September 2021**.

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral Fellowships aims to develop the creativity and innovative potential of experienced scientists by working on an individual interdisciplinary research and training project and international and intersectoral mobility. The program offers the opportunity to invite scientists from all over the world to implement projects at the Jagiellonian University, which is crucial for the development of the staff, raising their own level of scientific development and transfer of knowledge in the international environment.

Therefore, I encourage the JU researchers to act as a supervisor for foreign scientists who want to conduct research at the Jagiellonian University.

Basic information about the call for proposals:

The program is intended for experienced scientists who, at the time of closing the call, have a doctoral degree and experience no longer than 8 years, and in the absence of a doctoral degree, can demonstrate at least 4 years of experience in conducting research.

The supervisor and the foreign scientist jointly prepare the application form. After receiving the grant, the supervisor supervises the employed scientist and provides support in organizational and administrative matters, including contacts with the Research Executive Agency. The qualifications and experience of the supervisor have an impact on the assessment of the application.

The subject of research covers all areas of knowledge, and its selection depends on the preferences of the applicant and the supervisor.

The activity covers two types of projects:

- **European Fellowships**, which enable researchers of any nationality to implement a grant lasting from 12 to 24 months in any EU country or associated with Horizon Europe;

• **Global Fellowships**, which enable researchers from the EU or a country associated with Horizon Europe to implement a grant in a third country, on a 12 to 24-month secondment basis, with a mandatory 12-month return phase to Europe.

- The grant rate is 100%.
- The resources for the researcher include, per person-month:
 - wage (living allowance): EUR 5,080 x national correction factor,
 - relocation costs (mobility allowance): EUR 600,
 - family allowance: 660 euro.
- Funds for the host institution per person-month:
 - training and research costs: 1000 euro,
 - management costs and indirect costs: 650 euros.

Scientists from the Jagiellonian University who are interested in creating teams "supervisor - foreign scientist" and applying for MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships implemented at the Jagiellonian University are asked to complete the form attached as Appendix 1 to the Announcement and send it to the CAWP call supervisor by 1 June 2021

On the basis of the submitted applications, an offer of the Jagiellonian University will be prepared, which will be published on the EURAXESS portal and sent to other European research units.
