**On: submitting applications for projects financed under the "ERC Advanced Grants" call for proposals.**

I would like to kindly inform you that the European Research Council has announced an open call for applications under the **ERC Advanced Grant** under the programme **Horizon 2020** (call identifier: ERC-2021-ADG).

The ERC Advanced Grants are designed to support outstanding researchers in their careers, where they are already recognized authorities in the field of their research with experience in leading a research team. The program is intended for scientists with above-average research achievements, and their ambitious projects will be groundbreaking.

**Application evaluation is a two-step process. In the second stage, an interview with the author of the application is planned.**

The call for applications lasts **until 31 August 2021, at 5.00 p.m.**

**Application conditions and rules:**

- The grant may be applied for by scientists who, being active researchers, are able to demonstrate significant scientific achievements in the last 10 years of their career.
- The project can be implemented in any institution, but it must be located in an EU member state or associated with the Horizon Europe program.
- Projects can cover all fields of knowledge. The subject of the project is determined by the applicants themselves.
- Interdisciplinary projects with high scientific risk, leading to important discoveries and breakthrough results will be highly appreciated.
- Negatively assessed applications result in a one-year or two-year grace period for re-submitting applications.
- The minimum involvement of the project manager in the grant implementation is 30%.
- The project co-financing rate is 100%.
- The maximum amount of co-financing for a project is EUR 2.5 million (under certain conditions - up to EUR 3.5 million) for projects lasting up to 5 years.
- Indirect costs represent 25% of direct costs, excluding subcontracting costs.

- Applicants are required to indicate in the **Funding & Tenders opportunities** as a contact person on behalf of the Jagiellonian University the CAWP call supervisor.

### **Internal regulations of the Jagiellonian University:**

In accordance with the Jagiellonian University Rector's Directive No. 56 on July 11, 2016 *on the rules of procedure for the preparation and implementation at the JU of projects financed from external sources*, researchers interested in participating in the call should submit to the CAWP:

- **by 17 August 2021:**
  - **Research Project Notification Form, and the VAT Eligibility Form** completed and submitted in the electronic system, Strefa Projektów UJ available at: <https://strefaprojektow.uj.edu.pl/>  
Instructions for filling in the forms are available at: <https://cawp.uj.edu.pl/strefaprojektow>,
  - **a working version of the application** (sent in a PDF file to the address of the CAWP call supervisor)
  - **Commitment of the host institution for ERC Calls 2021**  
To the address of the call supervisor in CAWP should be sent: one copy (without signatures) in the form of a PDF file and a second copy signed by the Principal Investigator and the head of the unit where the project will be implemented. The document template is attached as Appendix 1 to the Announcement;
- **by 31 August 2021 – a final version of the application** (electronic version in PDF file).

**The condition for the submission of the application is the acceptance of the Head of the unit and the JU Bursar on the Project Registration Form.**

Out of concern for the quality of submitted project applications please consult applications and submit documents to the CAWP in earlier dates than mentioned above.
