**on: submitting proposals in the programme "SPINAKER – International Intensive Programmes".**

This is to inform you that the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange (NAWA) has announced a call for proposals

on: **submitting proposals in the programme "SPINAKER – International Intensive Education Programmes".**

The main objective of the programme is the internationalisation of Polish higher education and research institutions by means of funding projects focused on:

- raising interest in the education offer of Polish institutions of science and higher education among foreign students and PhD students;
- increasing participation of foreign students and doctoral students in education programmes at Polish universities;
- expanding offer of intensive international programmes, also in a remote form.

The call for proposals is open until 30 November 2021, 3:00 p.m..

**Call essentials:**

- A project may be implemented over a period from 12 to 15 months
- It may be carried out between 1 June 2022 and 31 August 2023.
- The amount of funding allocated for the implementation of an individual project is no less than PLN 100,000.00 and no more than PLN 800,000.00.
- The following actions may be implemented under the project:
  - development of new intensive international study programmes, planned for implementation in a remote formula or in a formula combining stationary and remote form (blended learning);
  - adaptation of the existing intensive international study programmes in terms of:
    - their internationalisation, i.e. development in (a) language(s) other than Polish and enabling foreign student or doctoral student participation in the programmes, as well as
    - enabling implementation of programme(s) in a remote formula (in full or in part);
  - recruiting programme participants;
  - preparing teaching staff (through training courses and other forms of education) for the implementation of the programme(s);
  - implementation of the programme(s).
- Each project must provide for preparation, implementation and teaching at least one international intensive education programme.



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International Intensive Education Programme (IIEP) is to be understood as a brief (between 30 and 150 teaching hours) form of education intended for students or doctoral students from abroad.



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IIEP may be carried out as e.g.:

- summer and winter schools,
- specialist courses,
- training courses,
- study visits (including visits abroad),
- participation of foreign professors;
- additional education offer for programme participants,
- other form of enhancing attractiveness of international study programmes.

**JU internal regulations:**

In view of the fact that **one university may submit up to 3 proposals**, please submit declarations of application as per the specimen attached as Annex 1 to this communication by **15 October 2021 at the latest. Please make the selection and send in one proposal per entity.**

Project proposals may be submitted electronically (documents signed with a qualified electronic signature or as a scan with a handwritten signature)).

- A JU entity shall submit with the call assistant at the CAWP one proposal selected by the JU organisational entity head (dean, director / head of other organisational entity).
- A JUMC entity shall submit with the call assistant at the Research Department of the JUMC one proposal selected by the JU organisational entity head (dean, director / head of other organisational entity).

Based on the declarations you will have submitted, Jagiellonian University authorities will decide on the mode of further processing of the proposals. The call assistant at the CAWP or the Research Department at JUMC shall inform you of the decision of JU authorities.

Once the information on the proposals selected for further processing has been communicated:

- concerns JU entities:

The call assistant at the CAWP will contact the representative of the host entity of the selected project to determine individual dates for delivery of project documentation (i.e. an education project entry form and a VAT eligibility form, and a draft and the final version of the proposal).

- concerns JUMC research societies:

The call assistant at the Research Department will contact the representative of the host entity of the selected project to determine individual dates for delivery of project documentation (i.e. a research project entry form, a VAT eligibility form, project statistical data, and a draft and the final versions of the proposal).
