on: submitting funding proposals in the Lysiak-Rudnytsky Ukrainian Studies Programme.

This is to inform you that the Ukrainian Institute has announced a call for proposals under the Lysiak-Rudnytsky Ukrainian Studies Programme, intended to promote Ukraine internationally.

The call for proposals is open until 27 March 2022, 23:59 GMT+3.

Under a project funding may be granted to:

- translations of non-fiction texts from Ukrainian into foreign languages,
- publications of original texts on Ukrainian issues in foreign languages,
- public discussions and lectures (including online)
- creation and promotion of Ukrainian online content (publications, graphics) to further the goals of the Ukrainian Institute;
- publications on Ukrainian issues .

Terms and conditions of applying in the call are available on the websites:

Basic information on the projects:

- recommended minimum project value equals EUR 15,000, whereas the maximum has been set at EUR 20,000,
- the funding will cover 100 % of project costs,
- project implementation and should be completed by 30 November 2022,
- indirect costs may not be included in the budget,
- expenditures are provided for only in the form of a refund of incurred costs; the head of the JU organisational entity acting as the project's host entity (i.e. dean, director / head of other organisational entity) upon submitting the proposal therefore expresses their consent to the allocation of funds from the entity's budget for the implementation of the project.

JU internal regulations:

In view of the fact that **one university may submit up to 2 proposals**, please submit call entry declarations as per the specimen attached as Annex 1 to this communication by **7 March 2022 at the latest**.

I recommend that each Faculty/Entity select only 1 proposal. Nevertheless, should a JU entity wish to submit more call entry declarations, the Head of the JU organisational entity shall subject the declarations to preliminary verification and present them,

in the form of a list ordered by recommendation strength, sent alongside the declarations, to the call assistant at the RSC.

Project proposals signed by the Author and the Head of the organisational entity (i.e. dean, director/head of other organisational entity) may be submitted electronically (a document signed with a qualified electronic signature or in the form of a scan with a handwritten signature alongside a version of the proposal open to editing).

Based on the declarations you will have submitted, Jagiellonian University authorities will decide on selecting two project proposals. The call assistant at the RSC shall inform you of the decision of JU authorities.

Once the information on the proposals selected for further processing has been communicated, authors of the proposals shall be obliged to submit to the RSC:

- **by 17 March 2022:**
 - a **proposal draft** (electronic version sent as a pdf file to the address of the call assistant at the RSC, for the purposes of review and verification of formal eligibility;
 - a **research project entry form and a VAT eligibility form**, filled out in the electronic system **JU Project Zone** at: <https://strefaprojektow.uj.edu.pl/>,
- **by 23 March 2022** – the final version of the proposal (electronic version sent in as a pdf file signed with a qualified electronic signature or a paper version signed with handwritten signatures) – signatures required: project author and the head of the JU organisational entity (i.e. Dean or Director/Head of other organisational entity).
